

Customer Register Privacy Statement

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This privacy statement applies to the personal data register of Suuri Armo ry called Customer Register.

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Suuri Armo (registered association) collects and maintains personal data registers in order to carry out the task defined in its rules and related services in the churches it maintains. This privacy statement is a register and data protection statement in accordance with the EU General Data Protection Regulation 2016/679. By 'register' we mean an information system in which personal data are processed.

Purpose and legality of the processing of personal data

The purpose of the processing is to market, sell, and buy the services.

Legality is based on customer relationship.

Personal data is not used for direct marketing. The processing does not involve data profiling or automated decision-making.

Data content of the register

The customer register holds information that is relevant for an event, subscription, etc., such as name and contact information, age, food allergies, or information on guardians of minor children.

Some events have a separate, event-specific customer register with a separate statement. It is available when registering for the event.

Regular data sources

The data are collected in the registers from the data subject or his or her guardian with unequivocal consent. Information can be collected in registers, for example, at church events, in writing in connection with registration to events, or electronically on separate forms.

Regular disclosures and transfer of data outside the EU or the EEA

The data will be transferred outside Suuri Armo ry only to the extent that accounting obligations or official obligations require. The data will not be disclosed outside the EU or the EEA. The data may be stored in Microsoft Office 365 on servers located in the EU or EEA. The accounting material is stored on a server in Finland.

When selling and purchasing services, the customer register generates accounting material, which is disclosed to the performance auditor, accountant and, within the limits of the law, to the authorities in accordance with the Accounting Act.

Storage period of personal data

The information received on the basis of the customer relationship (such as camp activities, press subscriptions, trainings, other events) is stored for a maximum of two years after the end of the event, subscription or similar in question, or until the fees have been collected. The data collected in connection with the events will be disclosed to the persons in charge of the event, such as the children's supervisors, only to the extent required by the tasks, and this data will be destroyed after the event.

Register protection principles

In the churches maintained by Suuri Armo ry, manual material is stored in a locked space, access to which is restricted to those who need it to perform their tasks. Personal data in electronic format, with the exception of instant messaging applications, are stored in the association's secure cloud (which is protected by a firewall, usernames, and passwords) and in accounting, as applicable. The security of the website's server platform is the responsibility of the service providers.

Access to the data in the registers is restricted to those who perform the controller's duties and who need the data. A confidentiality agreement is made with them.

Duty to inform

The privacy statement is published on the website www.raamattupuhuuturku.fi and in connection with the collection of personal data. If necessary, a privacy statement will be published in connection with event-specific registration forms.

The data subject shall be informed without delay if the confidentiality, integrity, or availability of the register has been compromised so that it is likely to pose a high risk to the rights and freedoms of the data subject, for example in the form of identity theft, payment fraud, or other criminal activity. The necessary authorities are informed already when the data breach is detected.

Right to inspect and to demand rectification

Data subjects have the right to check their data stored in the personal data register, to correct any incorrect data, and to request the deletion of their data. The request must be made in writing to the controller's contact person. The applicant must prove his or her identity. The data subject has the right to lodge a complaint about the processing of their personal data with the Data Protection Ombudsman, P.O. Box 800, P.O.
